ICIN focuses attention on the interplay between web and telecom technologies, services and players, and end users. [ICIN 2011](#) will be held on October 4-7, 2011, in Berlin, Germany.

The regular **Technical Paper** programme at ICIN 2011 will be supplemented by a combined **Poster and Demonstration** session. This extended session allows the presentation of late-breaking results, on-going research projects, and speculative or innovative work in progress. Posters and demos aim at providing authors and attendees with an even greater opportunity to gather and to discuss technical issues about their work.

Submissions are invited for Demonstration / Poster sessions as well as for Technical Paper sessions. Prospective authors have until 7 March 2011 to submit their review manuscripts for ICIN 2011. Review manuscripts should be submitted electronically through EDAS at <http://edas.info/N9791>.
