Telco de-perimeterisation: do you know what it means?

De-perimeterisation is a concept from the security world, describing a strategy that can lead to the removal of outer security boundaries. It's a radical approach that could provide telecom operators with a tremendous opportunity.

Operators who embrace the de-perimeterisation of communication services could extend their reach, allowing the provision of secure services and data on a global basis irrespective of underlying network ownership.

These concepts emerged from contributions and subsequent debate at the last [ICIN](#) conference. They are explored in an [article](#) recently published in [Connect-World](#).
